I am excited to announce the beginning of Phase 1 of the return to a new normal in our FBC Kids' Ministry.

We will begin this Sunday, July 5th with Children's Church meeting downstairs in the fellowship hall during the 11:00 service. Since we cannot have Sunday school or Sunday evening activities, we have extended the ages to kindergarten (5 years of age) through sixth grade. If you were asked to attend the 9:00 service, it is okay to switch if you would like to do so Social distancing will be practiced, and the room will be cleaned and sanitized after the service. We ask that you please drop your child/children off before the service begins in the fellowship hall. We will not be coming into the service to walk the students down. This will help us keep the social distancing guidelines we have in place.

We are also starting fresh with a new Children's Church leader/helper rotation. If you would like to sign up to help in children's church, please let me know as soon as possible. That will mean that each couple would serve roughly once every two months.

birth through high school, and we are trying to do as much as we can safely and in accordance with the government. We are not sure when Phase 2 will begin, but we are extremely excited to begin Phase 1.

Dear Church and Congregation,

My name is Patricia Keenan and I am the Community Advocate Coordinator for the South Central Human Resource Agency. We are the agency in Maury County which runs programs such Head Start/Early Head Start, Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) and my reason for contacting you today, the Senior Nutrition Service Program which includes a Meals on Wheels program.

In Maury County, we currently serve 69 seniors in our meal delivery program to whom we deliver a hot lunch five days a week. We are looking for additional people in the county to help us continue to serve these seniors. These meals enable our seniors to enjoy the comfort and safety of being in their homes knowing they have at least one hot meal a day during the week. Many of our seniors rely on this program due to mobility issues that can make it difficult to make regular trips to the grocery store or they have problems preparing or cooking meals on a regular basis. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the county's congregant site had to close and those clients were able to move to home delivery. In January and February we delivered 2138 meals, in March and April that number rose to 2412. We expect this trend to continue. However, also due to the pandemic, we need to replace volunteers as some of them were considered at risk themselves and had to stop to ensure their safety.

The opportunity to help is completely up to those willing to help. We recommend joining with a friend to deliver the meals thus making it easier for each person. You can deliver one day week or more. The lunches are packed at the Maury County Senior Center in Columbia each day by our center Site Director and are ready to go when the volunteers arrive. Delivery times are between 12:00 noon and 1:00pm. Volunteers will be given the same group of deliveries each time. Delivering to the same people allows for the volunteers to get to know the seniors they are delivering to. Sometimes this delivery is the only contact our senior has that day and the opportunity to create that connection and relationship with others is incredibly important.

In order to ensure that seniors in Maury County continue to receive this daily hot meal, we are asking for your help. If you have anyone in your congregation that would be interested in joining us in this important program for the seniors in Maury County, please do not hesitate to contact Sara Brown, Deputy Director or me at the information below.
