Isaiah 43:18-21 says, "Do not remember the former things, nor consider the things of old. Behold I will do a new thing..." In verse 18, God is saying "Don't rely on past victories because I am going to do more for you in the future than I have ever done before." Many Christians are content to live with pastor victories, but God wants to do more for you in 2020 than He ever did in 2019. He wants us to move on to an enlarged spiritual walk with a greater fullness of the Holy Spirit.



The new thing that God is going to do will "spring forth" (v. 19). It will be spontaneous. If you will open your heart to God and say, "I don't want to live for myself and be controlled by myself; I want to live by faith in Christ," then God's new thing will spring forth in your life. God will make a way through your spiritual wilderness. He will send a river to flood your spiritual desert. Reach out and accept the new thing God wants to do in your life today!

One of the purposes of this new thing is that God might provide for you. God delights in satisfying the needs of His children. When He sees one of us in the wilderness, He delights to put a spring there. God wants to do some productive things in your life and allow you to become all that He has saved you to be.

A secondary purpose for God's new thing is that your life will bring glory and praise to Him. Individually, you and I are to show forth His praise. But also, as a church, we are to show forth His praise. In 2020, God wants to enlarge your prayer life, enable you to be a vocal witness, and increase your faith not only to bless you, but that your life might give honor to Christ.

God also wants to do a new thing in the life of First Baptist in 2020. It would be easy for us as a church to be content with our past victories. It is easy sometimes to just coast along. That would break God's heart. God wants to do more for our church in 2020 than He has ever done before! But in order for us to receive this new thing it will take commitment and work on our part.

Are you ready for the new things that God is going to do in your life in 2020? Don't be content with the former things. If you are satisfied with your spiritual life, you will become stagnant and passive and you will go backward.

God wants to do a new thing in your life. He wants to enlarge your capacity for a great love for Him, for His Word, His church, and His work. Allow Him to do that in your life.
