announced Grand Marshals Dale Winston Riggs (Korean War) and Beverly Williams (Vietnam). Beverly began active duty in 1966 where she was assigned to MAC Air Force Base in IL to hospital nursing. She then served in Danang, Vietnam, 22nd Casualty Staging Flight from April 15, 1968 to April 15, 1969. Upon being promoted to rank of captain, Beverly's assignment was to treat and prepare casualties from all branches in Norther I Corps for evacuation for additional care. After returning home, Beverly joined the CA Air National Guard, becoming part of the 146th Aeromedical Evacuation Squadron in Van Nuys, CA before graduating from flight school in 1971. Beverly became inactive after marrying, but remained on reserve status until she was honorably discharged in 1987. Beverly says she is excited and humbled to serve as one of the grand marshals in the Parade.

The parade begins at Columbia Plaza on W. 7th St. and passing the Memorial Building before turning on S. High St. at the Polk Home and ending at the Mulehouse.
